GIVING DISCIPLESHIP JOURNEY Where do you find yourself on this giving journey?



CONSISTENT GIVER

INITIAL GIVER

(Matthew 7:24) Someone who decides to give for the first time, out of a response to God's Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something and trust God and the leaders of the church with this gift. They experience the initial joy of putting Jesus' word into action.

(2 Corinthians 8:7) Someone who decides to give something on a consistent basis to exercise the discipline of giving as a disciple of Jesus. Often, someone who decides to make their gift an online recurring gift will be someone who is learning the joy of consistency. Non-online givers can be consistent givers as well; it just requires more discipline. They experience the joy of excelling in this way of giving.



PRIORITY GIVER

(Matthew 6:19-24 and Colossians 1:15-20) Someone who understands the pre-eminence of Christ and that He is above all things - that everything was created by Him, for Him, through Him, and to Him. This giver places such a priority on their giving that it drives their spending and their saving, as opposed to their spending and saving driving their giving. They experience the freedom of serving "one master," declaring Jesus first.

ETERNAL GIVER

(1 Timothy 6:19)
Someone who sees the eternal impact of their giving, not just the immediate programs and ministries it helps accomplish. This giver has been captivated and moved to "do good, be generous, and share." This encourages them to keep growing. They make all decisions (big purchases, savings, giving, etc.) in light of how it will affect their eternal impact.



SURRENDERED GIVER

(Ephesians 5:1-2)

Someone who recognizes that Christ surrendered His whole self for us, and therefore desires to surrender their whole selves to Him, in love. This giver would say "My giving is not just changing my spending and saving... It's also changing me!" This informs how they use everything they've been blessed and entrusted with – whether that be through direct monetary giving or through a God-honoring use of an existing resource (i.e. honoring God with the use of your home, etc.).

1. Paul is encouraging the early church at Philippi that they are still "in process" in their faith and God is still completing a "finishing" work in them. Do you feel you are "in process" on your faith journey right now? What specific ways are you feeling that in your life currently?

3. Paul talks in this passage about being "filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ – to the glory and praise of God." SCRIPTURE:

Read Philippians 1:27; 2:1-18.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:



2. As you read the first half of the chapter 2 passage (Philippians 2:1-11), you see a major thread of humility. Humility requires surrender—surrender of ourselves, surrender of our own desires and ambitions, surrender of a comfortable life to one that is devoted to His plans and purposes. As you read this passage and reflect on the humility of Christ's surrender on the cross, reflect on your own assessment of your humility or lack thereof. Do you consider yourself a person of humility, or is this something you struggle with in your faith? Why or why not?



3. In verse 12, what do you think it means to "work out your salvation with fear and trembling?" Part of the goal of this MOVE journey and this LIMITLESS series is to stay the course, to stay on the journey, and to continue pursuing God with a LIMITLESS faith. This looks different for each of us. What does it look like for you in your current season of life?
4. Paul shares in the last part of this passage, vs. 14–18, about being poured out like a drink offering on the sacrifice and service coming from our faith. He also shares we should do everything without grumbling or arguing. Where do you think this is coming from as he shares this? What might have been true about these early believers that would cause Paul to address this? Do you feel you need this instruction in your life right now? If so, how?

PRAY:

During this midpoint of the MOVE journey, we are praying that 100% of us at RiverGlen would take a step of faith in one of three ways:

- 1. For those who have not yet joined the MOVE journey, be challenged to step out in faith and make a commitment to generosity for our final year of MOVE. Trust God in this area of giving and take that step with us as a church as we boldly trust Him with a LIMITLESS faith.
- 2. For those who are on the MOVE journey and still deeply engaged and challenged, be encouraged. Commit to finish strong. There is a reason why you made your original commitment, so be encouraged in that as you step out in faith during this final year of MOVE. Be bold. Stay the course together.
- 3. For others on the MOVE journey, you stepped out in faith last year, and your journey has not been easy. PRAY:

Pray for what God will do in each one of us through the LIMITLESS series and what He will do in our church.

SCRIPTURE:

Read Philippians 3:7-21.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. What does it mean to consider all things you have gained to count them as loss for the sake of knowing Christ? What does this mean for you specifically in your current life situation?

2. Paul talks about "becoming like Christ in his death" so that we can "attain resurrection." What might it mean to become like Christ in his death? What SHOULD we be pursuing in our daily lives as opposed to the things we currently pursue right now?

12 of chapter 3, Paul again humbly shares that he has not yet arrived in his faith journey. If we are honest, specifically on the topic of generosity that we've been discussing during this MOVE journey, we can often feel as though we have "arrived" when it comes to our giving. Because our giving is quantifiable, we can mistakenly "check the box" of giving without truly growing. How have you felt you have grown in your generosity (not just numerically) during MOVE? How have you felt stagnant and maybe need a fresh challenge of growth?

4. Philippians 3:13-14 epitomizes the heart of this LIMITLESS series – to press on towards this goal calling us heavenward in Christ Jesus. Paul mentions "forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead." What do you need to forget that is behind? Share or reflect as honestly as you are able.

PRAY:

Pray for your own journey and each person in our church as they consider their next steps in MOVE. For those who are NEW to the journey, to take a bold step of faith. For those who are ON MISSION, to finish strong. And for those who are CHALLENGED, to increase their level of commitment.

2. Why is it important our peace and gentleness be evident to others, as Paul shares? How does the witness of our anxiety or our peace affect other people's view of God? Do you have a personal testimony about how either your anxiety or your peace has affected someone else's perspective of God?

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith.
